PERKINS SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

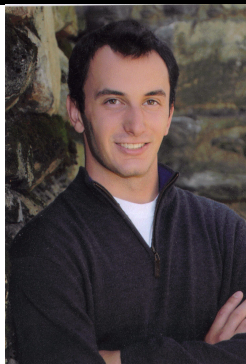
Congratulations to MHS graduate Conor Davis, the 2012 recipient of the Eric Perkins Memorial Football Scholarship.
